Impact of lung disease

- Over 12 million people in the UK have been diagnosed with lung disease and 550,000 new diagnoses are made each year.
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) is a term used to describe a number of conditions including emphysema and chronic bronchitis.
- An estimated 1.2 million people are living with diagnosed COPD and prevalence is increasing.
- The cost of prescribing inhaled medication in the UK is almost £1 billion yet inhaler technique is poor.
